

Build Your Own Critical Zone: Post Visit Activity

Taking Care of Your Plants

- Watering: Make sure your soil stays moist – add an extra tablespoon of water if you see it drying out.
- Sunlight: You should see sprouts starting to grow after a few days. Once your plants sprout, place them in a sunny location.
- If your plants outgrow the original pot, ask an adult for help replanting them in a larger container.

Observation Log: Record what you see happening in your mini-critical zone. You can draw a picture, measure and record the height of your plants, record the number of leaves, and describe other things you see.
