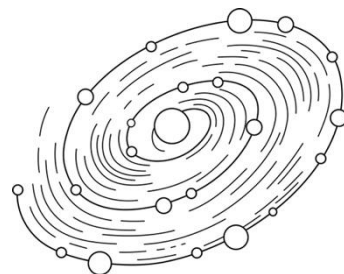


Flandrau Science Center and Planetarium: Level 1 Scavenger Hunt

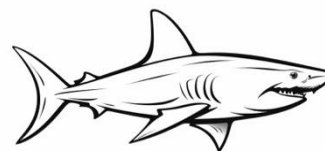
