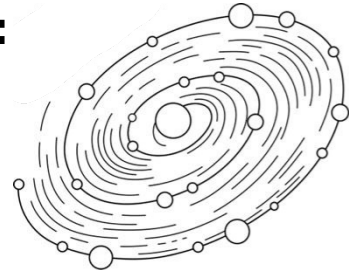


# Flandrau Science Center and Planetarium: Level 1 Scavenger Hunt

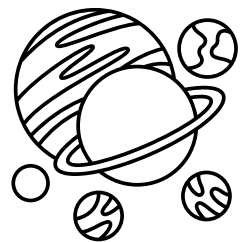
**Wild World of Bugs:** Shrink down into the world of insects to find the answers to these questions!

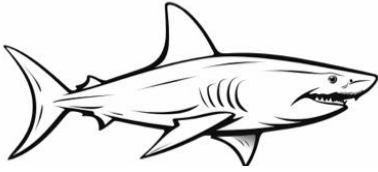

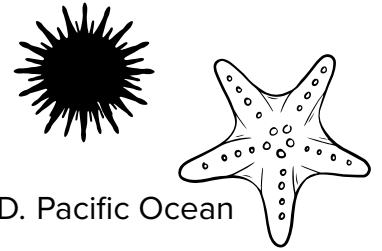

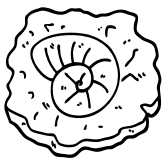
